

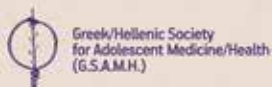

The venue of Athens as a city of memorable beauty with a deep history of healing from the roots of humanity has a symbolism that will infuse this convening. The ORIGAMI CRANE is a symbol that calls for solidarity in our global pursuit for hope and a better life for all-- through the myth a Japanese girl, Sadako.

Our social program will establish space to engage personally to establish a foundation of collegueship to sustain our ongoing work and friendships. We hope you will also use your time in Athens to visit famous museums and monuments, and to explore nearby cultural destinations, such as Sounion, Delphi and Nafplion-Epidauros, that will further enrich your experience.

We are looking forward to seeing you in Athens-Greece! Please come to share your knowledge and experience and your commitment and passion for the wellbeing of children and families, and to launch our future collaboration.

- 1. The text should be written in Word document for Windows and should not exceed 250 words. Suggested font is Arial 10pt.*
- 2. Abstract Title : Use initial bold type letters for the title. The title should reflect the various aspects of the project.*
- 3. Authors : After the title, the name of the first author (presenting author) and co-authors will follow. Use initials for first and middle names, followed by the last name (do not type last name first), Underline the presenting author's name.*
- 4. Institutions: the list of authors names should be followed by the author's institutions), city, state or province and country.*
- 5. Skip a line between institution and text.*
- 6. At the end, full details of the presenting author must be mentioned (name, address, cellular phone and e-mail)*
- 7. You are kindly requested to note if you wish to present your paper as oral or poster presentation.*
- 8. All abstract will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee. Confidentiality of their contents will be respected by all members of the Committee.*
